

Basic Hooded Cowl



Cowl is worked in one piece except for edging.

Materials:

Bulky yarn (6), 280 Yds.

6.5 mm hook

Gauge:

10 dc and 5 rows = 4 in (cm)

Size:

Fits most teenagers and women.

Abbreviations:

Sc: Single crochet

Ch: Chain

Sl st: Slip stitch

Dc: Double crochet

Hood

Row 1: Create a sc base of 28 stitches and continue to sc along the opposite side of your sc base (56 sc).

Row 2: Ch2 (does not count as a stitch through pattern) turn. Dc in each sc around (56 dc).

Row 3: Ch2 turn. Dc in each dc around

Rows 4-11: Repeat row 3. Do not turn.

Neck

Row 12: Sl st in first Dc of round 11. Ch2, dc in each dc around. Join with sl st to first dc. (56 dc.)

Rows 13-15: Ch2, dc in each dc around. Join with sl st to first dc.

Row 16: Ch1, sc in each st around. Fasten off.

Edging

Row 1, join yarn with sl st to base of neck (where you started the neck). Ch1, sc evenly around edge of cowl opening. 2-3 sc per dc. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

Add buttons for decorative purposes at front of neck if desired.

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
